302-2 Energy consumption for business trips (shuttle bus between Eschborn and Luxembourg, company cars and flights)

We do not collect data on the average fuel consumption for our company cars; instead, we used the national average for new car registrations (5.9 I / 100 km). Energy consumption figures for flights taken as part of business trips are based on the person kilometres flown. The average figure for this published by the Bundesverband der Deutschen Luftverkehrswirtschaft (BDL, the German Aviation Association) is 3.64 I / 100 km per passenger. The consumption values of the shuttle buses are based on the data of the transport company (depending on the size of the bus between 10 I and 29 I / 100 km).
