



Eurex/Deutsche Börse Scholarship to the University of Oxford

Together with St. Anne's College at the University of Oxford, Deutsche Börse Group has awarded the Eurex/Deutsche Börse Group Scholarship since 2007. The scholarship is aimed at particularly gifted students at the college who would otherwise not be able to study at Oxford for financial reasons.

The annual grant is awarded to applicants studying Physics, Mathematics, IT, PPE (Politics, Philosophy and Economics), Engineering, Business and/or Management. Students of any nationality in their first or second year of study can apply. A St. Anne's College selection panel decides on the basis of the applications submitted and an interview who will receive the grant. The recipients are given the opportunity to complete an internship at Eurex in the company headquarters in Frankfurt/Eschborn in the summer vacations of their second or third year of study. The costs of travel and lodging are covered by Deutsche Börse AG. The maximum level of funding is £10,170 per year; it is based on the cost of living of an undergraduate student in Oxford and partly covers the tuition fees. The total amount of the grant donated by the Company can also be split between two suitable candidates. The grant is renewed each year for up to a total of four years provided academic performance is at least "satisfactory".
